KDOT to begin survey for K-33 overpass replacement

Starting Monday, June 8 and continuing for six weeks, weather permitting, the Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) will conduct a field survey at the BNSF Railway overpass on K-33 at Wellsville.

The survey is taking place to gather information necessary for a detailed design of the proposed future replacement of the overpass. The survey length is ½ mile north and south of the rail crossing along the existing K-33 alignment.

Activities will include the use of survey instruments on the ground to determine locations of existing features within the corridor. A member of the survey crew will contact property owners and/or tenants for permission to enter private property. Rob Selley, P.S., Survey Project Manager, will be in charge of this survey for KDOT.
