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KDOT to begin field survey for bridge replacement on U.S. 59/160

Starting Monday, Feb. 23, and continuing for three weeks, weather permitting, the Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) will conduct a field survey at the bridge over Labette Creek on U.S. 59/160 in Labette County. The bridge is approximately five miles west of Oswego.

The approximate length of the survey will be 0.6 mile along the U.S. 59/160 highway corridor.

The survey is taking place to gather information necessary for a detailed design of a proposed project to replace the bridge. Activities will include the use of survey instruments on the ground to determine locations of existing features within the corridor. A member of the survey crew will first contact property owners and/or tenants for permission to enter private property. Joseph Bowen, P.S., Field Survey Manager, is in charge of this survey for KDOT.
