Railroad crossing in Neodesha will close to traffic for repairs

The Union Pacific Railroad plans to close its rail crossing on U.S. 75 in Neodesha for repairs Tuesday through Thursday, June 7-9, weather permitting.

U.S. 75 will be closed to through traffic at the crossing during this three-day period. Northbound U.S. 75 traffic should use the following detour on Neodesha streets: from U.S. 75 take Water Plant Rd. and continue north to Tank Ave., then turn east (right) on Tank and proceed to 4th St., then turn south (right) on 4th and continue to U.S. 75. Southbound traffic should use the following detour route: from U.S. 75 turn north (right) on 4th and continue to Granby Ave., turn west (left) on Granby and proceed to U.S. 400, then turn east (left) on U.S. 400 and continue to U.S. 75.
