## **K-146 east of U.S. 59 to close Friday for rail repairs**

Friday, Jan. 23, the Union Pacific (UP) Railroad plans to repair its crossing on K-146 in Neosho County. The crossing is located 1.6 miles east of U.S. 59.

**The highway will be closed to all through traffic at the crossing from 8:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. on Friday.** Eastbound K-146 motorists will follow a signed detour on the following routes: from K-146 travel south on U.S. 59 to the south junction of U.S. 59/K-47, then east on K-47 to the K-47/K-3 junction, then north on K-3 to K-146.

Westbound K-146 motorists will follow the same route in the opposite direction.
