K-383 resurfacing project to start in Decatur County

The Kansas Department of Transportation plans to begin a resurfacing project on approximately 7.5 miles of K-383 in Decatur County on Monday, May 10.

Project work will consist of a 2-inch mill and inlay beginning near the south city limits of Jennings and ending at the Norton County line. Traffic will be directed through the work zone by flaggers and a pilot car during daylight hours, and minor delays should be expected.

KDOT anticipates work to be completed by the end of May, weather permitting.
