U.S. 281 to close north of Russell

The Kansas Department of Transportation plans to close a portion of U.S. 281 in Russell County to through traffic on Monday, March 15, weather permitting.

The closure will begin at 15th Street in Russell and extend north to Land Road. Traffic will be detoured via I-70, K-232 and K-18.

The closure is part of a \$9.8 million T-WORKS project to rehabilitate and reconstruct approximately 4 miles of U.S. 281 in Russell County. Work began in March 2020 and is expected to be complete in December 2021.
