K-15 Utility Work in Marion County

Beginning Monday, April 25, 2016, Utility work will take place on K-15 3.5 miles north of the city of Durham. The work will be focused on the east side of the highway requiring traffic to be reduced to one lane.

Traffic will be controlled by traffic signal with a reduced speed limit of 35 mph. This project is scheduled to be complete by April 29th weather permitting.
