Work began yesterday, Sept. 21st on a surface recycle and chip seal on K0177 in Chase County. The project begins at the Butler/Chase County line then north to the Council Grove south city limit.

Traffic will be reduced to one lane controlled by flaggers and a pilot car for the duration of the project. This project is scheduled to be completed on or about November 19th weather permitting.

The purpose of the repairs is to extend the life road and improve ride quality.

Dustrol Inc.is the prime contractor. Project cost is \$3,151,641.00.
