K-57 resurfacing to begin in Geary & Morris counties

Dwight – A 20-mile milling and hot-mix asphalt overlay project will begin on Tuesday, Sept. 5, at the junction of K-4/K-57 in Morris County, continuing north to the K-57/I-70 junction in Geary County. Traffic will be reduced to one 11' lane controlled by a pilot car and flagger operation during daylight hours. Drivers should expect delays of less than 15 minutes and plan extra time in their travel schedules.

The project is scheduled to be completed, weather permitting, by Oct. 31. Shilling Construction Company, Inc. of Manhattan is the prime contractor on this \$1,492,112.84 project.

KDOT urges all motorists to be alert and obey the warning signs when approaching and driving through a highway work zone.

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
