Overlay project on U.S. 36

Washington County – A 4-mile asphalt overlay surfacing project on U.S. 36 began today, Aug. 28, at the Little Blue River bridge, continuing east to the Marshall County line.

Construction will take place during the day, and traffic will be reduced to one 11' lane following a pilot car through the work zone. Drivers should expect delays of less than 15 minutes and plan extra time in their travel schedules.

The project is scheduled to be completed, weather permitting, by October 31. Hall Brothers, Inc. of Marysville is the prime contractor on this \$1,377,991.67 project.

KDOT urges all motorists to be alert and obey the warning signs when approaching and driving through a highway work zone.
