## **Survey scheduled for U.S. 77 in Geary County**

Kansas Department of Transportation surveyors will soon be conducting work on U.S. 77 to gather information necessary for the replacement of Rush Creek Bridge located 1 1/2 miles north of the north U.S. 77/K-57 junction. The field survey effort will begin on or about August 14, and is scheduled to take approximately six weeks.

A member of the survey crew will first contact property owners and/or tenants for permission to enter private property. Survey activities will include the use of survey instruments on the ground to determine locations of existing features within the survey corridor.

Kara LaRiviere, Field Survey Project Manager, will be in charge of this survey for KDOT.
