Maintenance work will disrupt KDOT online services on Sunday

System maintenance will cause disruption of the Kansas Department of Transportation's online services between 6 a.m. and 4 p.m. on Sunday, Sept. 13.

The Office of Information Technology Services will be performing equipment maintenance at the Eisenhower State Office Building in Topeka, causing periodic disruption to KDOT's [website](#) and email system. Among the services that will be affected is travel information through KanDrive, which includes road conditions, camera views, electronic sign information and more. Electronic message signs along I-70 will not be updated during the maintenance work. The 511 traveler information phone line also will not be updated during the maintenance activity.
