KDOT requesting comments on STIP document

The Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) requests comments on the FFY 2017-2020 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) draft document.

The STIP is prepared annually and is a project specific document that lists all KDOT administered projects regardless of funding source including projects for counties and cities as well as projects on the State Highway System for a four- year period. The draft STIP document may be viewed on-line at
