K-92, Amelia Earhart bridge inspections set

Routine bridge inspections on the K-92 bridge in Leavenworth County and the Amelia Earhart bridge on U.S. 59 in Atchison County are scheduled to take place. All bridges on the State Highway System are inspected every two years.

The K-92 bridge inspection is set for Monday, May 20, from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. with the two-lane bridge being closed to traffic during this time. Motorists will need to use alternate routes.

The Amelia Earhart bridge inspection is scheduled for May 21 and 22. Traffic on the four-lane bridge will be reduced to one lane eastbound on May 21 and one lane westbound on May 22.

The scheduled inspection dates are weather permitting as high wind and rain can affect the planned inspections. Lift trucks will be used to inspect the high steel.
