

# Projects That Will Be Let To Construction

## List Overview

Attached is the list of projects that KDOT will still be letting to construction in FY 2010. Projects on this list fall into 3 categories:

1. **Comprehensive Transportation Program (CTP) projects.** These are projects that KDOT has already committed to under the CTP and involve the final phases of the project (i.e. surfacing, installing fiber-optic cable). These projects are highlighted in blue on the attached list.
  - a. US-54 in Kingman County for \$31 million
  - b. K-61 in McPherson and Reno counties for \$2 million
2. **American Recovery & Reinvestment Act (ARRA) projects.** These projects are funded through federal and local dollars. These projects are highlighted in green on the list.
  - a. There are 20 ARRA projects on the list totaling \$112 million on the list.
3. **City & County Projects.** These are small projects that are funded primarily through federal and local dollars. These projects generally involve resurfacing.
  - a. There are 98 city and county projects on the list totaling \$87 million. Of that only \$14 million is state dollars.

**TOTAL: There are 120 projects on the list for \$232 million; of that \$47 million is state dollars.**
