KDOT announces approved September low bids

The Kansas Department of Transportation announces approved bids for state highway construction and maintenance projects in Kansas. The letting took place Sept. 19 in Topeka.

District One – Northeast

Douglas –U.S. 59 from the Franklin-Douglas county line north 4.2 miles, seeding and sodding. Truelsen Blumenthal Llc Dba Soil-Tek, Grimes, Iowa, \$127,574.80.

Johnson – K-10, 4.4 miles east of the Johnson-Douglas county line, bridge repair, Comanche Construction Inc & Subsidiary, Shawnee Mission, \$26,540.00.

Nemaha – Slope protection on the U.S. 36 bridge 0.4 mile east of the west junction of K-53, slide repair, King's Construction Company Inc., Oskaloosa, \$131,887.10.
