Pothole patching continues in Johnson County this week

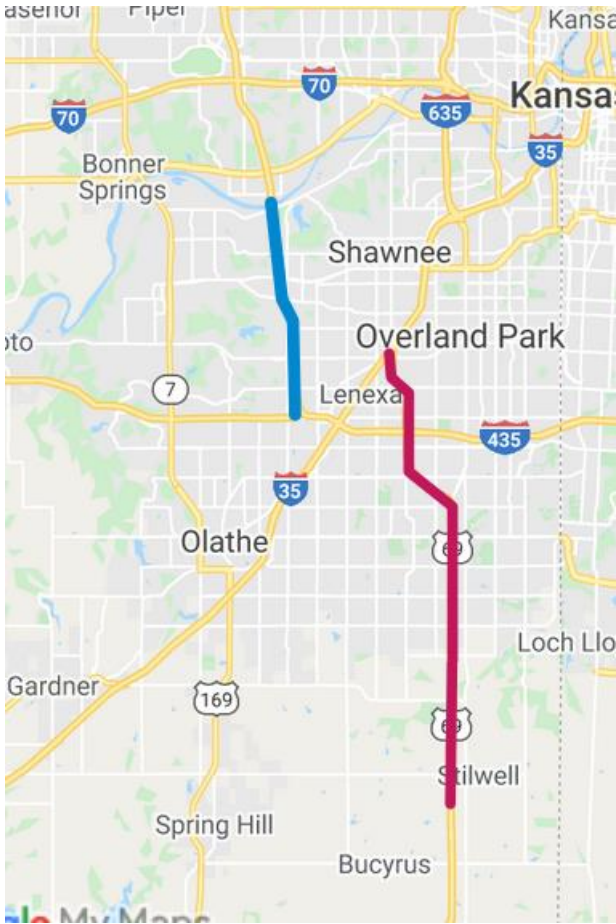
The Kansas Department of Transportation will continue pothole patching in Johnson County this week, weather permitting.

I-435 northbound and southbound will have various mobile lane closures from the Kansas River to K-10 for pothole patching. Work will occur from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. and is expected to be completed Fri. March 6.

U.S. 69 northbound and southbound will have various mobile lane closures from the Miami County line to I-35 for pothole patching. Work will occur from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. and has been extended to Wed. March 4.

Traffic will be controlled by mobile lane closures using trucks with arrow boards and digital message boards
