Pothole patching in Johnson and Wyandotte counties Feb. 27 and 28

The Kansas Department of Transportation will be performing pothole patching at multiple locations in Johnson and Wyandotte counties, Feb. 27 and 28, from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., weather permitting.

Wyandotte County –

18th Street/US-69, northbound and southbound, will have alternating lane closures from I-70 to Steele Road on Thursday, Feb. 27.

K-5, northbound and southbound, will have alternating lane closures from I-635 to Sunshine Road on Thursday, Feb. 27.

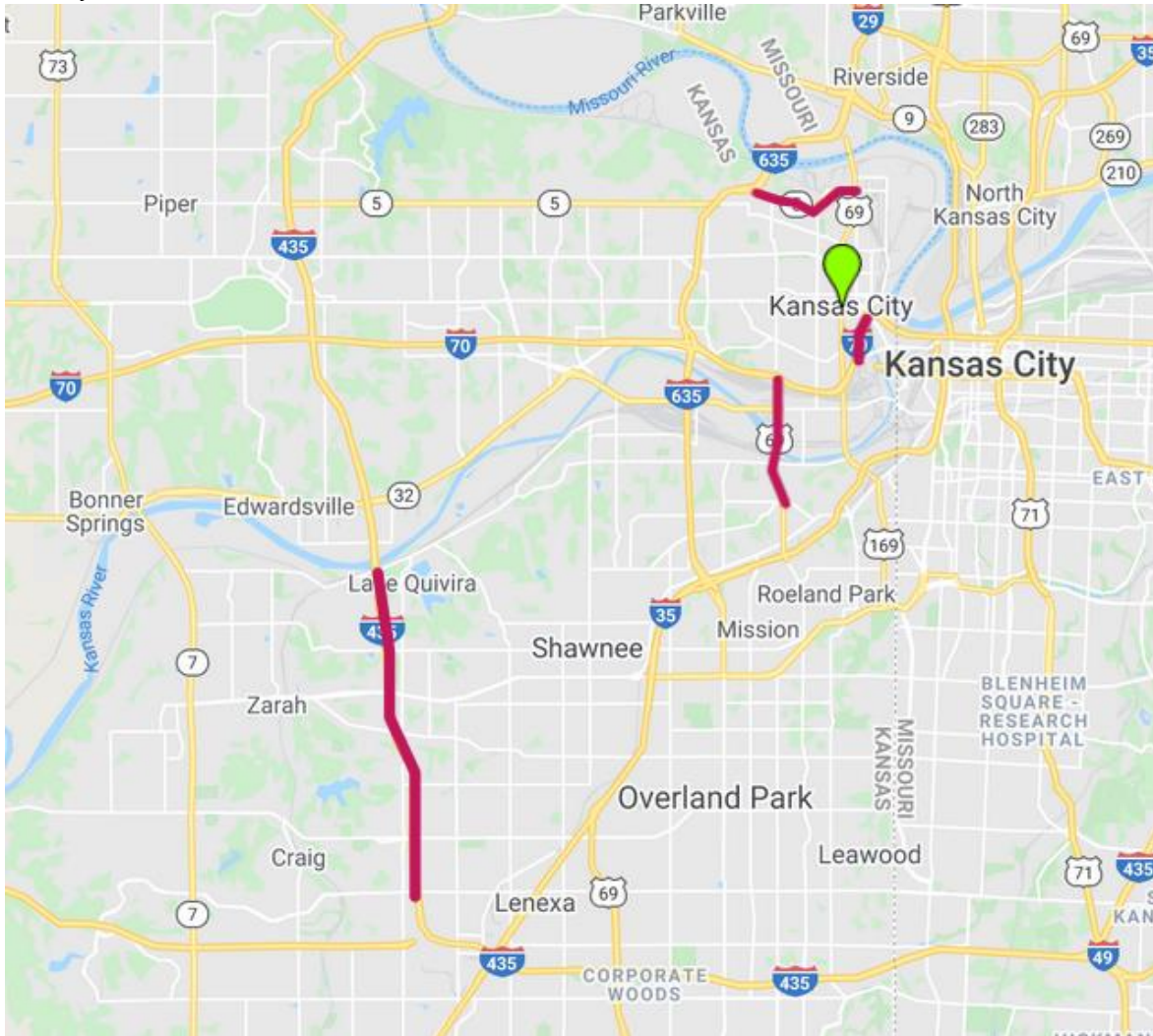
I-70 eastbound will have alternating lane closures from I-670 to James Street on Thursday, Feb. 27.

Johnson County –

I-435 northbound and southbound will have various mobile lane closures from the Kansas River to 95th St. Work is expected to be completed Friday 2/28.

Traffic will be controlled by mobile lane closures using trucks with arrow boards and digital message boards.
