Additional lane closures in Johnson County tonight and next week

Lane and ramp closures are scheduled in Johnson County, Thursday, July 2 to Thursday, July 9, weather permitting. Traffic on all these projects will be diverted using mobile lane closures, signage and traffic cones.

For pavement patching to prepare for overlay, the closures include:

- Two left lanes of southbound I-435 closed from Midland Drive to 95th Street, from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m., Thursday, July 2.

For asphalt milling and overlay, the closures include:

- Left lane of northbound K-7, from Johnson Drive to the Kansas River bridge from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m., Thursday, July 2.

For median maintenance, the closures include:

- Left lane southbound U.S. 169, north of 175th Street, from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., Monday, July 6.

For pavement coring, the closures include:

- Left lane and right lane of eastbound and westbound Shawnee Mission Parkway, between K-7 and Monticello Road. Samples will be taken of the concrete for testing. Work will occur from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., Monday, July 6.

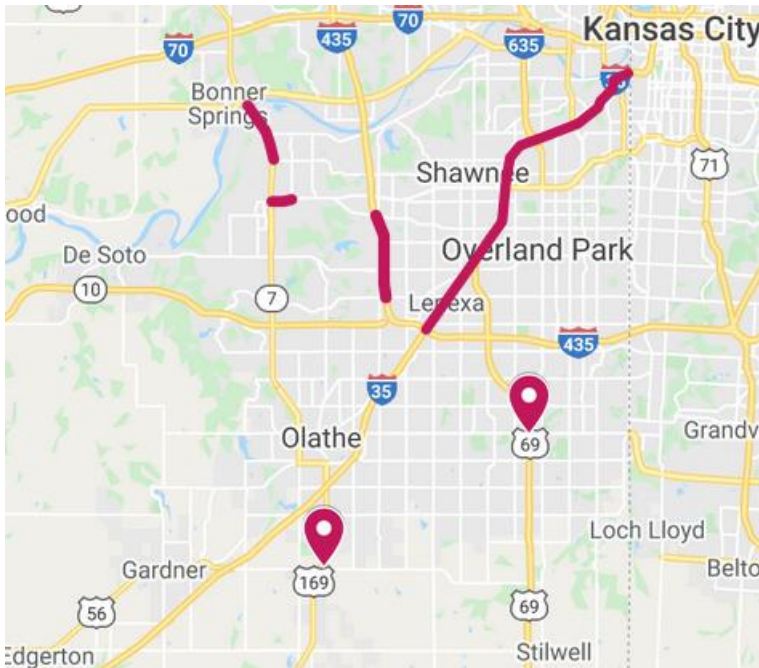
For pavement maintenance, the closures include:

- The eastbound 135th Street to southbound U.S. 69 off ramp, from 9 a.m., Monday, July 6 to the afternoon of Wednesday, July 8.

For pothole patching, the closures include:

- Alternating lanes, between the two left lanes and the two right lanes of northbound and southbound I-35, from I-435 to the Missouri state line. Work will occur from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., Monday, July 6 to Thursday, July 9.
