Additional lane closures in Johnson County

Lane and ramp closures are scheduled in Johnson County, Friday, June 26 to Thursday, July 2, according to the Kansas Department of Transportation, weather permitting. Traffic on all these projects will be diverted using mobile lane closures, signage and traffic cones.

For pothole patching, the closures include:

- Alternating two left lanes and alternating two right lanes of northbound and southbound I-35 from I-435 to the Missouri state line, 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., Monday, June 29 to Thursday, July 2.

For guardrail maintenance, the closures include:

- Left lane of eastbound K-10, from Woodland Road to Ridgeview Road, 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., Monday, June 29.


For pavement patching to prepare for overlay, the closures include:

- Two right lanes of northbound I-435 closed from 95th Street to Midland Drive, from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m., Saturday, June 27.
- Off ramp from northbound I-435 to Midland Drive and the northbound I-435 on ramp from Midland Drive, from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m., Saturday, June 27.

For asphalt milling and overlay, the closures include:

- Left lane of southbound K-7, from 83rd Street to just south of K-10, 7 p.m. to 6 a.m., Friday, June 26.

KDOT urges all motorists to be alert and obey the warning signs when approaching and driving through a highway work zone. To stay aware of all road construction projects across Kansas go to www.kandrive.org or call 5-1-1. Drive safely and always wear your seat belt.
