Numerous lane, ramp closures scheduled to begin July 10

Numerous lane and ramp closures in the Turner Diagonal area in Wyandotte County are scheduled to begin on Friday, July 10, according to the Kansas Department of Transportation.

The following ramps will be closed starting Friday at 6 a.m. with the closures scheduled to be in effect until Sept. 8. The ramp closures will include:

- Ramp B on eastbound I-70 to southbound Turner Diagonal Freeway
- Ramp D on eastbound I-70 to northbound Turner Diagonal Freeway
- Ramp C, northbound Turner Diagonal Freeway
- Ramp A, southbound Turner Diagonal Freeway to westbound I-70

Lane closures will take place only on Friday and are necessary for barrier work, sign truss removal. The lane closures will include:

- 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. - eastbound I-70 right lane at Turner Diagonal Freeway
- 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. - westbound I-70 right lane at Turner Diagonal Freeway
- 7 p.m. to midnight - westbound I-70 left lane at Turner Diagonal
- 7 p.m. to midnight - eastbound I-70 right lane at Turner Diagonal
- 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. July 11 - left lane at northbound Turner Diagonal Freeway at I-70
- 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. July 11 - left lane at southbound Turner Diagonal Freeway at I-70
