**Lane and ramp closures in Johnson County tonight and Tuesday**

Lane and ramp closures are scheduled in Johnson County, Monday, July 27 and Tuesday, July 28, weather permitting. Traffic on all these projects will be diverted using mobile lane closures, signage and traffic cones.

**For pavement patching, closures include:**

- Two right lanes, southbound I-435, from 79<sup>th</sup> Street to 95<sup>th</sup> Street, the on ramp at 95<sup>th</sup> Street, and off ramp from 87<sup>th</sup> Street, from Monday, 7 p.m. to Tuesday, 10 a.m. The 95<sup>th</sup> Street on ramp is expected to reopen at midnight Monday.

**For the addition of new shoulder grading material, closures include:**

- Two right lanes, northbound I-435, from K-10 to Midland Drive, and ramps below, from Monday, 7 p.m. to Tuesday, 6 a.m.
- Eastbound K-10 ramp to northbound I-435 closed as needed. Detour: eastbound K-10 to southbound I-35, exit at 119<sup>th</sup> Street, then northbound I-35 to westbound I-435 to northbound I-435.
- Northbound I-435 ramp from westbound I-435/westbound K-10 spur from I-35 as needed. Detour: southbound I-35, exit at 119<sup>th</sup> Street, then northbound I-35 to westbound I-435 to northbound I-435.

**For asphalt milling and overlay, closures include:**

- Northbound and southbound K-7, intermittent lane and ramp closures, from K-10 to the Kansas River, Monday, 7 p.m. to Tuesday, 6 a.m.

**For KC Scout camera work, closures include:**


- Right lane as needed, westbound 119<sup>th</sup> Street at I-35, Tuesday, July 28, 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

**For guardrail maintenance, closures include:**

- Southbound U.S. 69 on ramp from eastbound 87<sup>th</sup> Street, Tuesday, 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

These detours and lane reductions could take several minutes. Motorists are encouraged to add extra time to their travel schedules or use alternate routes.
