**Lane and ramp closures in Johnson County tonight and tomorrow**

Lane and ramp closures are scheduled in Johnson County, Thursday, July 23 and Friday, July 24, weather permitting. Traffic on all these projects will be diverted using mobile lane closures, signage and traffic cones.

**From 7 p.m. tonight to 6 a.m. Friday, the following closures will take place:**


- Eastbound K-10 to northbound I-435 ramp will be closed intermittently. Traffic will detour on eastbound K-10 and southbound I-35, exit at 119th Street, go north on I-35 and take westbound/northbound I-435.
- Northbound I-435 ramp from westbound I-435/westbound K-10 spur from I-35 will be closed intermittently. Traffic will detour on southbound I-35, exit at 119th Street and take northbound I-35 to westbound/northbound I-435.
- Southbound I-435 – two right lanes closed from Midland Drive to 87<sup>th</sup> Street, and the on ramp from Midland Drive.
- Northbound I-435 – two right lanes closed from K-10 to Midland Drive. The northbound on and off ramps at 95th Street, 87th Street and Midland Drive will be intermittently closed, but not at the same time.
- Northbound and southbound K-7, intermittent lane and ramp closures at 75<sup>th</sup> Street.

**For KC Scout camera work:**

- On ramp from 63<sup>rd</sup> Street to southbound I-35 will be closed intermittently, Friday, July 24, 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

These detours and lane reductions could take several minutes. Motorists are encouraged to add extra time to their travel schedules or use alternate routes.
