**Maintenance work in Leavenworth and Wyandotte counties this week**

Leavenworth County -

The City of Leavenworth will be replacing the light fixtures on the Centennial Bridge, Wednesday, April 22, to Thursday, April 24. Work will occur from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Traffic will be reduced to one lane, using signage and a flagging operation.

Wyandotte County -

The Kansas Department of Transportation will conduct pothole patching, Tuesday, April 21, in Wyandotte County, weather permitting.

Eastbound and westbound I-70, will have alternating lane closures, from KTA/61st Street to the Missouri state line.

Northbound and southbound I-635, will have the right lane closed from the Wyandotte County Line to State Line Road.


Work will occur from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Traffic will be controlled by mobile lane closures using traffic cones, trucks with arrow boards and digital message boards.

The Kansas Department of Transportation will also have the following ramp closures Monday, April 20, to Thursday, April 23, from 8 a.m. to 3:30 pm and 6 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. for road sealing, weather permitting.


- Southbound I-635 to eastbound I-70
- 38<sup>th</sup> Street to westbound I-70
- Westbound I-70 to 38<sup>th</sup> Street
- Westbound I-70 to northbound I-635
- Westbound I-70 to southbound I-635

Traffic will be diverted using signage and traffic cones.
