## **Maintenance projects in Jefferson, Johnson and Wyandotte counties**

Ramp and lane closures are scheduled in Jefferson, Johnson and Wyandotte counties, Friday, June 5, according to the Kansas Department of Transportation. Traffic on all these projects will be diverted using mobile lane closures, signage and traffic cones.

Wyandotte County –

For grading work, the closures include:

- The ramp from southbound Turner Diagonal Freeway to westbound I-70, from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Johnson County –

For pipe work, closures include:

- Right lane on southbound I-35, from 65<sup>th</sup> Street to 75<sup>th</sup> Street,
- Ramp closure at 67<sup>th</sup> Street to southbound I-35. Work will occur from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.


For bridge painting, the closures include:

- Two left lanes of northbound I-35 at 87<sup>th</sup> Street and the ramp from 87<sup>th</sup> Street to northbound I-35. Work will occur from 8 p.m. Friday, June 5 to 10 a.m. Saturday, June 6.


Jefferson County –

For pavement overlay, the closures include:

- Single lane on northbound U.S. 59 from 126<sup>th</sup> Street to Hickory Point Road, north of Oskaloosa. Traffic control will include a flagger and pilot car operation, from 6 a.m. to 7 p.m.
