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Mill and overlay on U.S. 56 in Johnson County to begin Monday

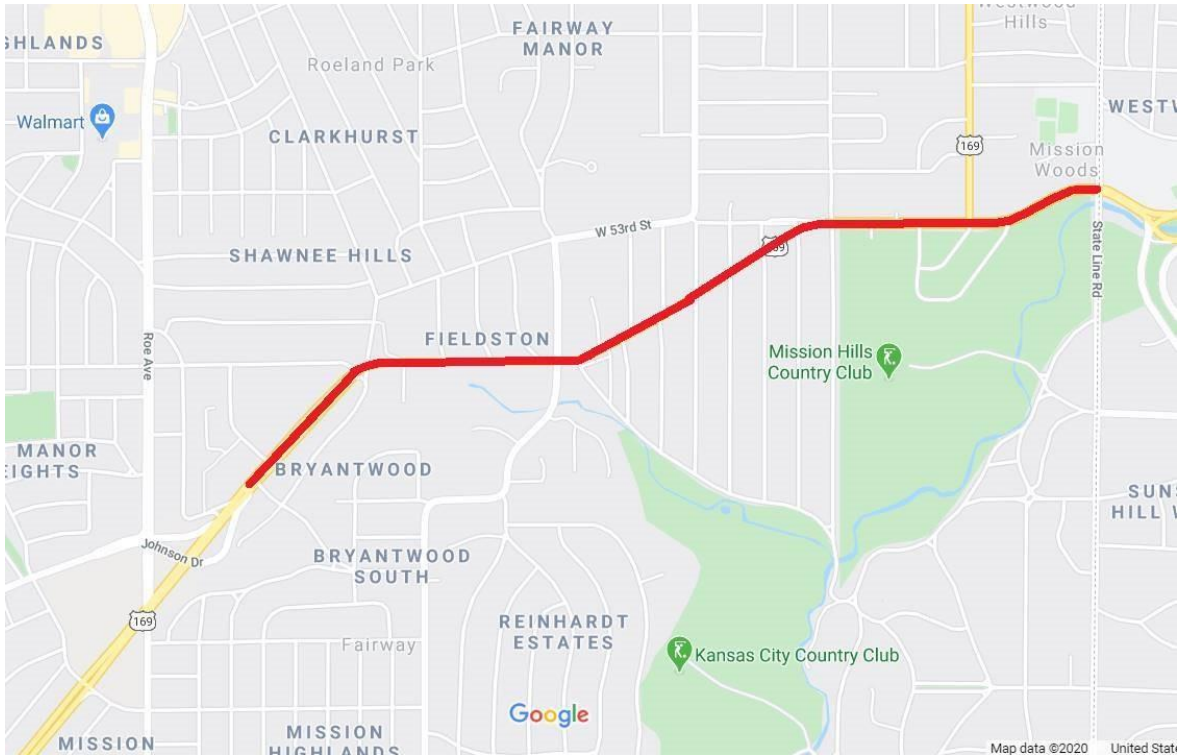
A mill and overlay project on U.S. 56/Shawnee Mission Parkway in Johnson County, to begin, Monday, June 8, weather permitting. Work will occur from Johnson Drive to the Missouri state line. The project is expected to be completed at the end of June.

This project will include two days of asphalt patching, five days of mill and overlay work and four days of pavement marking.

Traffic will be controlled with intermittent lane closures, lane width restrictions, flashing arrow boards, traffic cones and signage. Motorists should expect travel delays.

Superior Bowen of Kansas City, Mo. is the contractor on the \$850,000 project.
