Additional lane closures in Johnson County this week

Lane and ramp closures are scheduled in Johnson County, Monday, July 6 to Wednesday, July 8, weather permitting. Traffic on all these projects will be diverted using mobile lane closures, signage and traffic cones.

For pavement patching to prepare for overlay, the closures include:

Two right lanes of northbound I-435 closed from 95th Street to Midland Drive, and the two left lanes southbound I-435, from Midland Drive to 87th Street, from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m., Thursday, July 2.

For asphalt milling and overlay, the closures include:

- Intermittent lane closures northbound and southbound K-7, between Johnson Drive and Shawnee Mission Parkway, and intermittent ramp closures at 83td Street from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m., Monday July 6.


For bridge maintenance, the closures include:

- Southbound U.S. 69 on ramp at 135th Street from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., Monday, July 6 to Wednesday, July 8. Work will occur over Tomahawk Creek.

For pothole patching, the closures include:

- Alternating lanes, between the two left lanes and the two right lanes of northbound and southbound I-35, from I-435 to the Missouri state line. Work will occur from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., Monday, July 6 to Thursday, July 9. COMPLETE
