**Ramp and lane closures in Wyandotte and Leavenworth counties**

Ramp and lane closures are scheduled in Wyandotte and Leavenworth counties, next week, according to the Kansas Department of Transportation. Traffic on all these projects will be diverted using mobile lane closures, signage and traffic cones.

Wyandotte County –

For grading work, closures include:

- The ramp from southbound Turner Diagonal Freeway to westbound I-70. Ramp will be closed, Tuesday, May 26 to Friday, May 29, from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

For Intelligent Transportation Systems work, closures include:

- The ramp from northbound Turner Diagonal Freeway to westbound I-70. Intelligent Transportation Systems work includes the installation of sensor, computer, electronics, and communications technologies to provide traveler information. Ramp will be closed, Tuesday, May 26, from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

To install pavement markings, the closures include:

- The two left lanes of southbound I-635 from 43<sup>rd</sup> Street to K-32 and intermittent short-term ramp closures from southbound I-635 to eastbound I-70 and from westbound I-70 to southbound I-635. The lanes will be closed May 26, from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.
- The two left lanes of westbound I-70 from 65<sup>th</sup> Street to 78<sup>th</sup> Street and the following ramp closures:
  - Westbound I-70 to northbound and southbound Turner Diagonal Freeway,
  - Northbound and southbound Turner Diagonal Freeway to westbound I-70,
  - Westbound I-70 to 78<sup>th</sup> Street.

Ramps and lanes will be closed Saturday, May 30 from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.

- The ramps to and from the westbound I-70 truck parking area will be closed for short periods.

#### Leavenworth County –


Bridge maintenance work, the closure includes:

- One lane on the Centennial Bridge on K-92, over the Missouri River in Leavenworth. This work is ongoing and will continue to Friday, May 29 from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Traffic will be reduced to one lane, using signage and a flagging operation.
