Ramp and lane closures in Leavenworth and Wyandotte counties
next week

Additional ramp and lane closures are scheduled in Leavenworth and Wyandotte counties, Monday, July 6 to Saturday, July 11, weather permitting. Traffic on all these projects will be diverted using mobile lane closures, signage and traffic cones.

Leavenworth and Wyandotte counties –

For paving, the closures include:

- One lane northbound and southbound U.S. 73, from State Avenue to Ida Street, 6:30 p.m. to 6 a.m., Monday, July 6 to Saturday, July 11.

Wyandotte County -

For pavement patching, as part of the I-635 overlay project, the closures include:

- Ramp closures northbound I-635 at Merriam Lane from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m., Monday, July 6 to Wednesday, July 8.
- Ramp closures northbound I-635 at Shawnee Drive, from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m., Monday, July 6 to Wednesday, July 8.
- Ramp closures northbound I-635 at Metropolitan Avenue, from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m., Tuesday, July 7 to Friday, July 10.
- Ramp closures northbound I-635 at Swartz Avenue, from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m., Tuesday, July 7 to Friday, July 10.

For bridge joint replacement project, the closures include:

- Ramp closure westbound I-70 to southbound I-635, and southbound I-635 to K-32/Kansas Avenue, from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m., Monday, July 6, to Tuesday, July 7, for traffic control set up.
