**Additional ramp and lane closures, Jefferson, Leavenworth and  
Wyandotte counties**

Additional ramp and lane closures are scheduled in Jefferson, Leavenworth and Wyandotte counties, Saturday, July 18 to Saturday, July 27, weather permitting. Traffic on all these projects will be diverted using mobile lane closures, signage and traffic cones.

**Jefferson County –**

For pavement grinding, the closures include:

- Single lane closure on U.S. 59, from K-4 moving north. Work hours are 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. on Saturday, July 18. Traffic control will include a pilot car operation.

For pavement marking, the closures include:

- Single lane closure on U.S. 59, from K-4 moving north. Work hours are 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. on Sunday, July 19. Traffic control will include a pilot car operation.

**Leavenworth and Wyandotte counties –**

For chip and seal of shoulders, pavement grinding and pavement striping, the closures include:

- One lane northbound and southbound U.S. 73, from State Avenue to Ida Street, 6:30 p.m. to 6 a.m., Monday, July 20 to Saturday, July 27.

**Wyandotte County -**

For pavement patching, the closures include:

- Single and double lane closures southbound I-435 from State Avenue to K-32, Saturday, July 18, from 7 p.m. to 8 a.m., Sunday, July 19.
