Ramp and lane closures in Wyandotte and Leavenworth counties

A few additional ramp and lane closures are scheduled in Wyandotte and Leavenworth counties, according to the Kansas Department of Transportation. Traffic on all these projects will be diverted using mobile lane closures, signage and traffic cones.

Wyandotte County –

For sidewalk work, closures include:

- The right lane on northbound and southbound College Parkway, south of State Avenue to I-70. Lanes will be closed, May 21, from 8 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

To install pavement markings, the closures include:

- The two left lanes of northbound I-635 from K-32 to 43rd Street and intermittent short-term ramp closures from northbound I-635 to westbound I-70 and from eastbound I-70 to northbound I-635. The lanes will be closed May 21, from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m.

Leavenworth County –

For entrance construction at the new Quik Trip, the closure includes:

- The right lane of southbound U.S. 73 in Leavenworth County, from south of Muncie Road to Eisenhower Road. The lanes will be closed until June 8, from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.
