Updated traffic control information for
I-35/75th Street project in Johnson County

A lane widening project on I-35 from south of 67th Street to south of 75th Street is expected to begin March 20, weather permitting. Majority of the work will occur during daylight, however, night work is expected during particular phases of construction. The project is expected to be completed in late November.

****Updated traffic control schedule ****

Friday, March 20 –

9 a.m. to 3 p.m. the right lane of southbound I-35 will close.

8 p.m. the two left lanes of southbound I-35 at 67th Street will close till Sunday, March 22 at 9 p.m.

9 p.m. 75th St. Bridge over I-35 will close till Saturday at 11 p.m.

10 p.m. Southbound I-35 traffic will be shifted over to southbound exit ramp to 75th Street and the southbound on ramp from 75th Street to I-35.

Saturday, March 21 –

8 p.m. Southbound I-35 traffic will be shifted off of the southbound exit ramp to 75th Street and the southbound on ramp from 75th Street to I-35, into the southbound left lane till Sunday, March 22 at 8 p.m.

8 p.m. Southbound exit ramp to 75th Street and the southbound on ramp from 75th Street to I-35 will close till mid-July.

9 p.m. Open the 75th Street Bridge over I-35.


Sunday, March 22 –


8 p.m. All lanes of southbound I-35 at 75th Street will open.


The suggested detour is Antioch Road to 87th Street to Quivira Road. (See detour maps below) The southbound exit ramp from I-35 to 75th Street and the on-ramp from 75th Street to I-35 will close till mid-July.

Traffic will be controlled with barriers, traffic cones and signage. Alternative routes are suggested. The detour route for the remainder of the project is 75th Street to Antioch Road to Shawnee Mission Parkway till late November.
