Updates on lane and ramp closures in Johnson County this week

Lane and ramp closures are scheduled in Johnson County, Wednesday, July 8 to Thursday, July 9, weather permitting. Traffic on all these projects will be diverted using mobile lane closures, signage and traffic cones.

For pavement patching to prepare for overlay, the closures include:

- Two left lanes of southbound I-435 closed from 79th Street to K-10, from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m., Wednesday, July 8.

For asphalt milling and overlay, the closures include:

- Intermittent lane closures of northbound K-7, from Johnson Drive to the Kansas River bridge and the ramps at Shawnee Mission Parkway, from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m., Wednesday, July 8.

For bridge maintenance, the closures include:

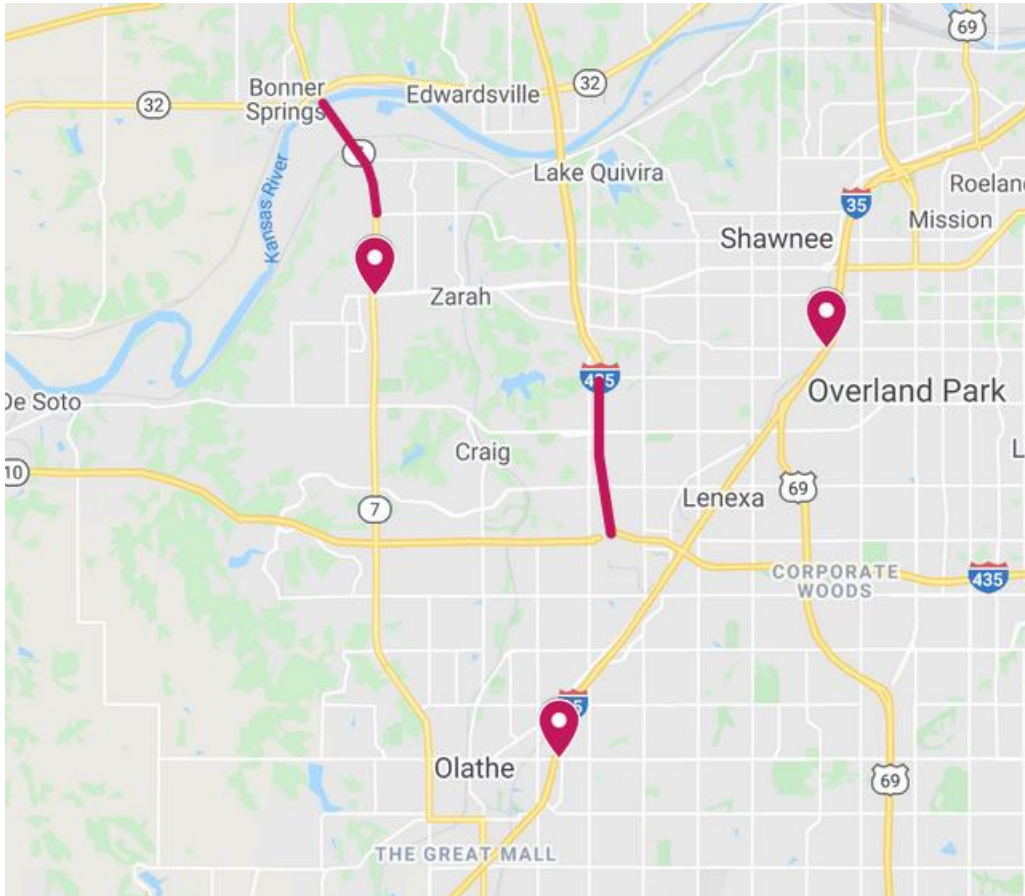
- Southbound U.S. 69 on ramp, at 135th Street, from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Project is on-going and the ramp closure has been extended to Thursday, July 9.

For the lane expansion project, the closures include:

- Southbound I-35 exit ramp from I-35 to 75th Street and the on ramp from 75th Street to I-35, has been extended to mid-August.

KDOT urges all motorists to be alert and obey the warning signs when approaching and driving through a highway work zone. To stay aware of all road construction
