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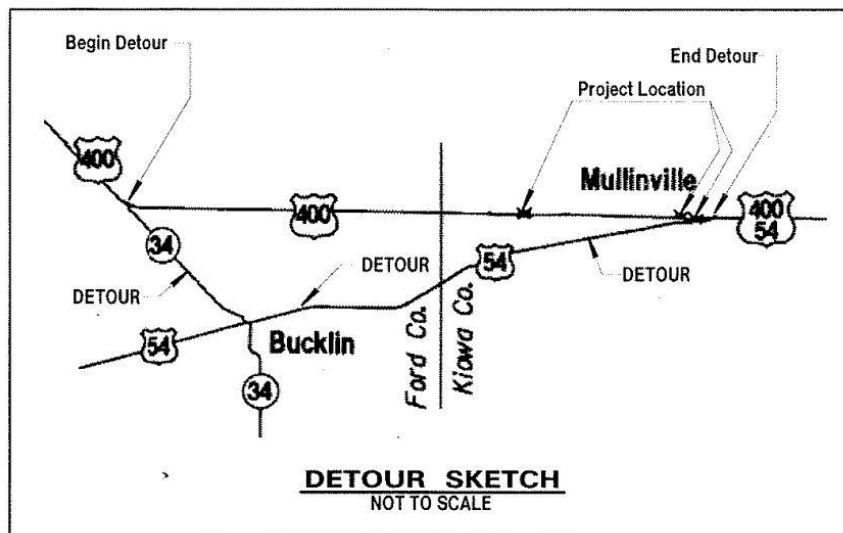
Bridge repairs scheduled in Kiowa County

Crews plan to begin making repairs Sept. 10 to three bridges in Kiowa County.

The bridges are all on U.S. 400. The first is over Rattlesnake Creek 1.82 miles east of the Ford/Kiowa county line. The second is 5.58 miles east of the Ford/Kiowa county line. The third is 5.78 miles east of the Ford/Kiowa county line.

U.S. 400 will be closed between the junctions of U.S. 54 and K-34 beginning Sept. 11.

PCi Roads LLC of Minnesota is the primary contractor for the \$706,224 project. It has 50 working days to complete work. A map of the detour is below.
